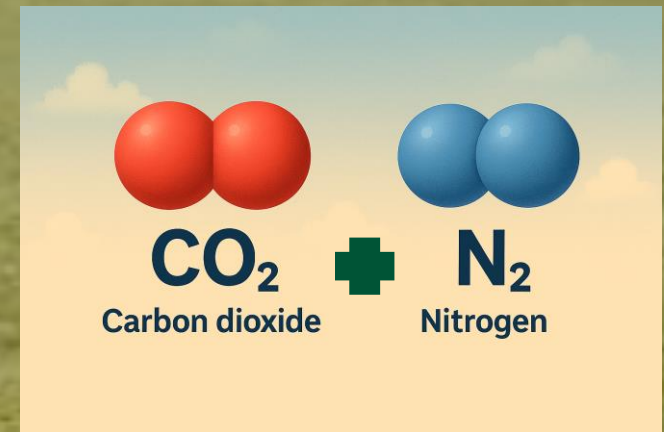

The purpose of the agreement

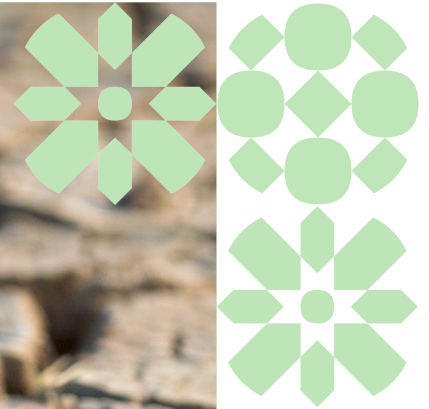


The purpose of the agreement have changed
